



# APPLAUSE LESSON SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

2017-2018 Academic Year

*Applause*, the LFHS music booster organization, encourages private musical instruction and is able to provide scholarships through Applause membership donations and fundraising efforts.

**Description:** Need-based Scholarships are made available to students in the LFHS music program to offset a portion of the cost of private, in-school music lessons from instructors selected by the music directors. The Scholarships cover one-half (½) of private lesson fees up to **\$150.00** per student per semester.

**Selection Criteria:** The Scholarships are need-based, as determined by the Music Directors.

## Instructions:

1. **How to Apply:** Complete and sign the attached *Lesson Scholarship Agreement Form* and have the *Form* signed by a parent and the private instructor. Submit the *Form* to your Music Director by **October 2, 2017** (Semester I) or **February 2, 2018** (Semester II). Your Music Director will notify you if your application is approved. A Scholarship is automatically renewed for Semester II upon successful completion of the semester and it is not necessary to submit the *Form* again. However, students must submit a new *Form* for each new school year.
2. **Cap on Payments:** The Scholarships cover one-half (1/2) of the cost of private lessons, up to **\$150.00** per student per semester. In no event will Applause pay more than half of the total lesson cost incurred or more than \$150 per semester.
3. **Student's Performance Requirements:** In order for *Applause* to pay the Scholarship amount, the student **must**:
  - Attend private instruction sessions regularly
  - Contribute positively to the school ensemble
  - Make progress in lessons, and
  - Complete four (4) hours of Volunteer Service to Applause or the LFHS Music Directors per semester (as described in #5 below).
4. **Payments to Instructors:** Students/parents are responsible for paying the private instructor on a weekly basis for their portion of the private lesson fees. *Applause* will pay the instructor directly at the end of the semester upon receipt of the invoice from the instructor and verification of the student's performance requirements (#3 above). If a student does not satisfy the performance requirements and forfeits some or all of a Scholarship award, the student will be responsible for paying the private instructor any balance due.
5. **Volunteer Service:** Students receiving scholarship funds are responsible for completing four (4) hours of volunteer service to *Applause* or the LFHS Music Directors before the end of each semester. The student will work with Music Directors to determine appropriate volunteer assignments. Examples of service opportunities with *Applause* include: help with mailings, volunteer at Spaghetti Dinner, usher at concerts.
